

Sax-Zim Bog

Our June Education meeting, held as always on the fourth Tuesday of the month, featured a presentation given by Clinton Dexter-Nienhaus, Naturalist of the Friends of Sax-Zim Bog. Many of us have heard of this place near the Iron Range avid birders like to visit in the winter to see some of the boreal species, most notably the Northern Hawk Owls and Great Gray Owls.

Clinton, after explaining the areas natural history, told the audience about his organization's mission and how since their founding in 2011 they have raised the money to acquire some parcels of the 500 sq miles of bog habitat in order to preserve it for future generations. A Welcome Center was opened in 2022 and several boardwalks have been built to observe nature.

The better part of the talk though was about the great bio-diversity of this former glacial lake. Roads crisscross the bog allowing observation of the habitat in all seasons. If you want to spend a couple days in nature just three hours north of Minneapolis checking out diverse habitat with everything from rare orchids to birds (over 3,000 documented species), then have a look at the Friends of Sax-Zim Bog website https://saxzim.org/about-sax-zim-bog/#statemap There are four Wildlife Management Areas in the bog as well as lots of other public land to explore.

Confession to a Raptor


